Course Descriptions

The Doctrine of the Last Things (TH 307): This course is a systematic study of future events, both on a personal level (death, resurrection, judgment, and the afterlife) and on a global level (the Rapture, the Tribulation, Christ's coming in power and glory, the Millennium, and the Eternal State).

Daniel (OT 130): A study of the historical background, interpretation, and theology of Daniel.

1 & 2 Peter and Jude (NT 219): This course will explore in a practical way the themes of holiness, suffering, relationships, spiritual growth, and guarding against false teaching as believers wait for the return of Christ

Biblical Creationism (TH 310): This course is a study of biblical creation. Emphasis will be given to God's supernatural creation of the universe in six successive days, the significance of the Fall to creationism, and the Noachic Flood and its extensive effects on the world.
