Course Descriptions

Ephesians (NT 212): This class will be an in-depth study of Ephesians. After a brief survey of the historical background, the focus will be on identifying Paul's theme and tracing its development, providing a paragraph by paragraph interpretation of Paul's argument, and discussing key theological themes.

Dispensationalism (ST 312): This course is a systematic study of the unfolding of God's revelation to man resulting in distinguishable economies or stewardships between God and man.

History of the Reformation (CH 409): This class will be a study of the Reformation period from the time of Martin Luther through the beginnings of the Puritan Movement in England. This course will focus on key figures and the contributions these figures made to Christian theology.

Principles of Spiritual Growth (PT 506): This course provides a theological framework for understanding spiritual growth in the context of God's overall work of salvation. It also provides practical help for the pursuit of godliness.
