### Kids' Korner: Sunday School Lessons

#### 1st-6th Grade:

"God requires holy living" (Leviticus 19:1–37) – *GoG Devotional Week 31*: p. 126

*Principle*: God is holy and wants believers to live holy lives.

*Ask Your Child*: What does it mean to be holy?

*Apply*: By obeying his or her father and mother.

#### 2s-K5:

Good News: Jesus Loves Me - "Jesus Loves Children" (Matt. 19:13-15; Mark 10:13-16); *God's Story for Me* pp. 394-99

Lesson Application: 1) How did Jesus show that he loves children? 2) How does God show us that he loves us? 3) Sing a song about God's love (such as "Jesus Loves Me" or "Jesus Loves the Little Children") and talk about what it means.

Bible Memory Verse: 2s-3s "I will be glad and rejoice in your love" (Ps. 31:7) & K4-K5 "Jesus said, 'Let the little children come to me.'" (Matt 19:14)
